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Introduction


The Process Measure patient lists provide managers with immediate information about the processes of care that are and are not being done for patients. These processes are identified best practices for home health patients and will be publicly reported at the agency level on Home Health Compare. By keeping tabs on the completion of process measures at the patient level, agencies can intervene quickly in cases where a patient did not receive treatment but should have, can identify clinicians who are less consistent about completing specific processes, and can course-correct when the agency as a whole is not meeting expected levels of performance to prevent poor results from being published.

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Report Structure

Grouping and Sorting

This report is grouped by clinician. Clinicians are sorted alphabetically. The clinician name is collected and displayed based on information transmitted from most MIS vendors. If we do not collect clinician name from the MIS vendor used by an organization, the reports will show "Unknown" as the clinician.

By default, patients under each Clinician are also sorted alphabetically. Users can resort by the values in any column by clicking the up/down arrows within the column header. A down arrow means the column is sorted in ascending order. An up arrow means the column is sorted in descending order. Note that sorting happens within each clinician group rather than for all patients.




Element	Definition
Patient Name (M0040)	Patient Name
Patient ID (M0020)	Agency-specific patient identifier
SOC/ROC Date (M0030/M0032)	Date of the start of care or resumption of care
Assessment Type (M0100)	Reason for assessment (RFA)
Assessment Completed Date (M0090)	Date Assessment Completed
Timely Initiation of Care	Was the SOC assessment completed on or before the physician-specified date OR within 2 days of the referral date or inpatient discharge date (whichever is later)? (M0102, M0104, M1000, M1005)
MD Notification Guidelines	Did the physician-ordered plan of care include patient-specific parameters for notifying physician of changes in vital signs or other clinical findings? (M2250a)
Depression Assessment	Was the patient screened for depression (using a standardized depression screening tool) at the SOC/ROC assessment? (M1730, M1710, M1720)
Depression Intervention	Did the physician-ordered plan of care include depression intervention(s) such as medication, referral for other treatment, or a monitoring plan for current treatment? (M2250d, M1710, M1720)
Falls Risk Assessment	Did patients 65 and older have a multi-factor fall risk assessment at SOC/ROC? (M1910)
Falls Prevention Steps	Did the physician-ordered plan of care include falls prevention interventions? (M2250c)
Pain Assessment	Has this patient had a formal pain assessment using a standardized pain assessment tool? (M1240)

Element	Definition
Pain Intervention	Did the physician-ordered plan of care include intervention(s) to monitor and mitigate pain? (M2250e)
Pressure Ulcer Risk	Was this patient assessed for Risk of Developing Pressure Ulcers? (M1300)
Pressure Ulcer Intervention	Did the patient, who was identified to be at risk for pressure ulcers, have the intervention to prevent pressure included in their physician-ordered plan of care? (M2250f)
Moist Wound Healing PrUlc Tx	Did the physician-ordered plan of care include pressure ulcer treatment based on principles of moist wound healing OR order for treatment based on moist wound healing has been requested? (M2250g)
Diabetic Foot Care & Pt Ed	Did the physician-ordered plan of care include diabetic foot care including monitoring for the presence of skin lesions on the lower extremities and patient/caregiver education on proper foot care?(M2250b)
